- a) Parish Hall

Nothing to Report.

Highways – Parking

West Buckland - Resurfacing the road between Phone Box and Chapel Cross – in next week or so. This should be done after they sort the collapsing wall not before.

Bantham – Hedge Trimming – what are the rules about this – can we find out and put in Village Voice

Resolved - Clerk to contact Adam Keay (Highways) – to make him aware of this. Copy in Cllr Gilbert plus ask about rules for hedge trimming.

b. Footpaths & Heritage Coast/Thurlestone Sands

Informed that Wall at Hallwell – cost $\mathfrak{L}3/4m$ this seems an awful waste of money when Pot Holes are not being repaired.

The footpath at Leasefoot beach which was re-routed recently is collapsing again Will need to be moved again. Golf club has spent £50k so far on clearing the land slips and put in boulders to protect the drain from marsh.

South Milton – Meeting re damage at Thurlestone Sands with National Trust – have advised that the road (washed away) will be restored.

d. School - Cllr Rhymes

Nothing to report.

e.Trees - Cllr Mitchelmore

Martin Grose has taken one down.

Mallards lost 3 and another 2 are dangerous so will need to be removed.

Merchants Garden had 3 come down and another 2 on the corner by Mallards One on Geoff Stidston,s land also came down.

Kennedy,s oak tree has permission to be loped.

On memorial green there is a large fir tree that could come down and if it does it could damage the memorial – needs to be surveyed.

Resolved Clerk to approach Aspect (Modbury) – to do survey.

The roots of the very large fir trees that were removed last year still not taken out-Can we obtain quotes x 3 to see how much this will cost.

Resolved - CIIr Rhymes to take forward

f. Parish Plan -

Mobile Phone Mast – Presentation was delivered on 27th February 11.00 am to 1.00 – William Osborne from Harlequin took questions – about 60 parishoners Attended. £150 m government funds available to give coverage to NOT SPOTS In rural areas. We are one of these areas – Arqiva/Harlequin have identified 2 Possible sites. They are negotiating with land owners.

Once sight agreed they will go for planning – message was – if you don,t support it – it goes elsewhere.

15- 20 meters height – not sure if Bantham and West Buckland would be covered at the moment – especially if option 1 – selected.

Will now wait for planning application once received will have either a separate Meeting or if possible tie in with our normal council meeting.

Agreed to inform Parishioners in advance – draft letter x 400 to be agreed.

Broad band – Report by Paul Martin - meeting at South Milton took place – and it seemed even more evident at this meeting that BT will be the preferred partner. As BT only bringing it to the Boxes – not the houses – some will still not get a great speed – as depends on how close you are to the box!

Decision to be made by end of March by BDUK.

Also evident that we cannot wait for the Broadband solution to tie in the Mobile Mast problem – will have to be dealt with separately.
