1. A question was asked by a member of the public referring to an article in the Daily Telegraph on 'Article 4', local authorities can remove national permitted development rights to protect local amenities. Question raised "Is there a legal framework to protect development of bungalows into houses – such as on the Mead estate and does the Parish Council have lobbying rights and option to comment on permitted development." Cllr Lewis confirmed that the Council can lobby on permitted development. Cllr Lewis requested that if members of the public could send any questions they want to raise in advance of the meeting to the Clerk, then the question might be included on the agenda for discussion.
