Comment

The Rock Box restaurant on the field belonging to the golf course has overstayed its 28 day entitlement. It has applied for an extension to its licensing but does not have planning permission to stay over the 28 days (this includes setting up days). It left Churchstow 29th June.

It has now demolished the old entrance way into the field, from the highway, which did not seek permission for.

People are walking down the road in the dark to I presume the toilets which is dangerous.

08/08/23

They have now gone but where there for 8-10 days over the allowance of 28 days. I was told both - that they had a licensing extension and that they couldn't move due to mud depending on who you spoke to. No planning was sought.

Last year, they overstayed by 4 days I believe.

The parishioner contacted planning enforcement and also our Councillor Samantha Dennis.

Parishioner concern is that this will creep each year and before we know it we will have a permanent site and this I feel would be a detriment in so many ways (noise, light, seagulls) not to mention dangerous (other locals have nearly run over people leaving the site with no torches and dark clothing)

The parishioner would be very grateful if this can be highlighted this at the next meeting.
